Water that is pure

I was pretty shocked to read recently the report that traces of cocaine can now be found in UK tap water due to its use being so widespread. Of course Public Health England did advise that the trace amounts 'aren't dangerous' but it brings into question yet again whether our tap water is really OK to drink – especially when we are told that we should be drinking at least eight glasses a day.

I've been agonising for years over the best water filtration system looking at jug filters, reverse osmosis filters, magnetic devices and even distilled water. I wish I had the definitive but in truth I'm still researching. I'll share my recent find with you. It's a structured water unit – what does that mean, I hear you ask? Well I'm told that structured water units work at molecular level to allow water to clean itself and rebalance as nature intended.

The fluid water unit was devised by Clayton Nolte, a physicist.
